St Alkmund's Church Tower

Climb 100ft to the top of the tower for a view of the surrounding countryside. The route will take you past the ringing room and allow a view of the Joyce's clock mechanism and the church bells before reaching the roof. Explore the Grade 1 listed building and examine the Parish Registers which will be available to view.

The church will be open **Friday: 1100 -1600 & Saturday: 1100-1600**

***Tours will commence at 1100, 1145, 1230, 1400, 1445 & 1530 both days**

Masonic Hall

This former Primitive Methodist Chapel dates from 1866 and retains original pews, balcony and a working organ. There will be access to the ground floor to view the museum of the two Lodges. There will be an opportunity to hear the organ being played.

The Masonic Hall will be open **Friday: 1100 - 1600 & Saturday: 1100-1600**

Whitchurch Ironfounders Walk

A 3 hour guided tour around Whitchurch exploring the history of the Smith family. Visit examples of their products located around the town. Walk starts and finishes at Whitchurch Heritage Centre

***Walks will take place** **Friday: 1300 -1600 & Saturday: 1300 -1600**

Whitchurch Heritage Centre

Come and look around our museum which tells the story of an historic Shropshire market town. Learn about Whitchurch's 18th & 19th century non-conformist chapels. Discover how many WW2 American hospitals operated in the locality.
